## 1715 - Blue sweater in Mayflower Cosmo.

<b>Size:</b>	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)
<b>Chest measurement in cm:</b>	100	(110)	120	(130)	140	(150)
<b>Length in cm:</b>	62	(64)	66	(68)	70	(72)
<b>Color 379, Petroleum blue, balls:</b>	15	(16)	16	(17)	18	(19)
<b>Circular needles (40 cm and 80 cm):</b>	US 10 ½/UK 2 (7 mm)					
<b>Double pointed needles:</b>	US 10 ½/UK 2 (7 mm)					
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower Cosmo. 100 % Wool Super wash, 62 m pr. 50 gram.					
<b>Gauge:</b>	Horizontal: 12 sts = 10 cm. Vertical: 18 rows = 10 cm.					

**To get the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.**

It is a good idea to read through the pattern before you start knitting, just like it is a good idea to knit a practice swatch and wet block it

The sweater is knitted on circular needles, the sleeves on double pointed needles; and it is knitted in raglan, so that there is only a little assembly.

At yarn change the yarn is spliced together: twist approx. 10 cm of the "old" yarn end and approx. 10 cm of the new yarn end. Take half of the old yarn end and half of the new yarn end and twist together and continue knitting. Cut off the loose ends.

### **Procedure.**

#### **Back/Front piece.**

- 1:** Cast on 124(136)148(160)172(184) sts on 80 cm circular needles US 10 ½/UK 2 and knit 6 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2:** Knit stockinette until you have a total of 43 cm. Applies to all sizes.
- 3:** Split the work into 2 equally sized pieces and fasten off 3 sts from the front piece and 3 sts from the back for armhole. Applies to all sizes. Let the work rest.

#### **Sleeves.**

- 1:** Cast on 22(24)26(28)30(32) sts on double pointed needles US 10 ½/UK 2 and knit 6 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1.
- 2:** Continue in stockinette and increase in every other sts; the increase 1 sts in the beginning and end of every 6th rnd until you have 58(62)66(70)74(78) sts.
- 3:** Knit until the sleeve measures 51(52)53(54)55(56) cm or desired length and fasten off for armhole like on the front/back
- 4:** Let the work rest and knit another sleeve.

#### **Seaming to raglan.**

- 1:** Start with the front piece, one sleeve, the back and the last sleeve.
- 2:** On every other rnd decrease for raglan like si: knit until you have 3 sts left on the front piece, knit 2 sts together through the back loops, purl 2 (1 sts from the front piece and 1 from the sleeve), knit 2 together. The same is done at the end of the sleeve and beginning of the back and so on the rest of the rnd. Applies to all sizes.
- 3:** Knit until you have made 14(16)18(20)22(24) raglan decreases. Change to 40 cm circular needles and continue in ribbing, knit 1, purl 1.
- 4:** Continue the decreases in the ribbing 5 more times and fasten off in ribbing. Applies to all sizes.

#### **Seaming.**

- 1:** Sew together under the arms, weave in the ends.
- 2:** Wet block the sweater.
