## 1717 - Woman's sweater with stripes in Mayflower Cotton 2.

<b>Size:</b>	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)
<b>Chest measurement in cm:</b>	100	(104)	108	(112)	116	(120)

<b>Color 31, Bordeaux, balls:</b>	3	(3)	3	(3)	3	(3)
<b>Needles:</b>	Circular needles US 2/UK 11 (3 mm) and US 4/UK 10 (3½ mm), 80 cm, needles US 2/UK 11 (3 mm) and US 4/UK 10 (3½ mm). Crochet hook US 11/UK 2 (3 mm).					
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower No. 2					
<b>Accessories:</b>						

To get the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.

**Stripes:** \* 10 r white, 2 r Bordeaux, 2 r white, 2 r Bordeaux, repeat from \*

### Body.

Cast on 212(220)228(236)248(256) sts with white on circular needles US 2/UK 11 and knit 10 rnds ribbing (alternately knit 1 and purl 1). then change to circular needles US 4/UK 10 and continue in stockinette and stripes (the 10 white rnds in the ribbing is counted in with the stripes) When the work measures 44(45)46(47)48(49) cm, split the work at the beginning of the rnd and after 106(110)114(118)124 (128) sts for back and front piece.

### Back.

Cast on 22 sts on both sides for shoulders = 150(154)158(162)168(172) sts. Continue over all sts in stripes like before. When the edge for the sleeves measures 17(18)19 (20)21(22) cm, fasten off the shoulders from the sides on every other r with 2 x 10 sts and 3 x 11 sts (1 x 10 sts and 4 x 11 sts) 5 x 11 sts (4 x 11 sts and 1 x 12 sts) 2 x 11 sts and 3 x 12 sts (1 x 11 sts and 4 x 12 sts). At the same time as the second shoulder cast off, fasten off the middle 38(40)42(44)46(48) sts for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side of every other r another 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. Knit the other side mirrored.

### Front piece.

Knit like the back, but with a V-neck: when the edges for the sleeves measures 4(5)6(7)8(9) cm, split the work in the middle for the V-neck = 75(77)79(81)84(86) sts on each part.

**Left front piece:** Decrease by knitting until the last 4 sts, knit 2 together and knit the last 2 sts.

On all the wrong side rows slip the first 2 sts purl wise with the yarn on the wrong side of the work. Repeat these decreases on every other r another 21(22)23(24)25(26) times. Fasten off the shoulder from the right side in the same height and the same way as on the back.

**Right front piece:** On the right side knit the first 2 sts and then decrease by knitting the next 2 sts pulled over together (= slip 1 knit wise, knit 1, pull the slipped sts over). On all the wrong side rows slip the last 2 sts on the neck purl wise with the yarn on the wrong side of the work. Fasten off the shoulder in the left side in the same height and the same way as on the back.

### Sleeves.

Start by knitting the bottom edge: cast on 25 sts with white on needles US 4/UK 10 and knit stockinette and in stripes, starting with 8(10)12(14)16(18) r white. On all wrong side rows slip the middle = the 13nd sts purl wise with the yarn on the wrong side of the work = hem. Repeat the stripes a total of 5 times and end with another 8(10)12(14)16(18) r with white = a total of 86(90)94(98)102(106) r. The work now measures 28½(30)31(32½)34(35) cm. Fasten off. With needles US 4/UK 10 and white, now knit 65(67)69(73)75(79) sts up along one side of the sleeve edge = 3 sts for every 4 rows. Continue in stockinette and stripes, while increasing 1 sts in both sides of every 6<sup>th</sup> row 5 times = 75(77)79(83)85(89) sts. When you have knitted 6

rows after the last increase, fasten off all sts loosely. Knit another sleeve matching.

**Seaming.**

Sew the shoulder hems. With white crochet a row of crab stitches along the neckline of the back, while tightening the work a little. Shorten the sleeves at the bottom and sew it to the inside with elastic sts. Sew on the sleeves and sew the sleeve hems. Press the work lightly with steam.
