1681 – Block-striped woman’s jacket in pastel colors in Mayflower Fake Fur.

Quality:	Mayflower Fake Fur. 100 % Polyester, 60 m pr. 50 gram.					
Gauge:	14 sts and 24 r in stockinette in needles US 8/UK 6 = 10 x 10 cm.					

To get the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.

Double edge stitches: On the right side you knit the first 2 and the last 2 sts. On the wrong side slip the first 2 and the last 2 sts purl wise with the yarn on the wrong side of the work.

Tip: It is a good idea to weave a tread into every right side row along your work, this makes it easier to count the rows in the height. It can be difficult to see with this yarn.

Back and front pieces.

Cast on 154(160)166(172)178(184) sts on circular needles US 8/UK 6 with light purple and knit back and forth in stockinette with double edge stitches in both sides for the front edges. Knit 22(23)23(24)24(25) straight up. Then change to light blue and knit another 22(22)23(23)24(24) cm straight up.

21(22)23(24)25(26) cm, knit the shoulder together with the corresponding shoulder on the back: lay the needles parallel together knit wise and knit the sts together with 1 sts from every row and fasten off the sts at the same time.

Back.

Let the outermost 42(44)46(48)50(52) sts in both sides rest for the front pieces and knit the back first over the middle 70(72)74(76)78(80) sts. Change to nude and fasten off for arm holes in both sides of every other row 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 4 x 1 sts = 52(54)56(58)60(62) sts. Then continue straight up, until the arm hole measures 21(22)23(24)24(25) cm and put the outermost 15(16)17(18)19(20) sts in both sides on stitch holders for the shoulders. Fasten off the middle 22 sts for the neckband.

Left front piece.

Knit like the right, but mirrored. The decreases in the neck is knitted like so: Knit until the last 4 sts, knit 2 together through back loops and end with the 2 double edge stitches.

Sleeve.

Cast on 34(36)38(40)42(44) sts in light purple on needles US 8/UK 6 and knit back and forth in stockinette. Increase 1 sts in both sides of every 8th row 12 times = 58(60)62(64)66(68) sts. At the same time, when you have knitted 22(22)23(23)24(24) cm in light purple, continue knitting in light blue when you have knitted 22 cm (all sizes) in light blue, change to nude, and at the same time fasten off for top shape in both sides of every other row 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts, 14(15)16(17)18(19) x 1 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 3 sts. Fasten off the remaining 10 sts. Knit a matching sleeve.

Right front piece.

Continue in nude and double edge stitches by the front edge. Fasten off for armhole in the left side of every other row 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 4 x 1 sts. At the same time, when you have knitted 8 rows in the arm hole, decrease for the neck like so: Knit the double edge stitches and knit 2 together. Repeat this decrease on every other row a total of 18(19)20(21)22(23) times = 15(16)17(18)19(20) sts. When the arm hole measures

Sew the sleeves together and sew them on.
