## EK3 - Loose women sweater in Mayflower Easy Knit.

<b>Size:</b>	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)
<b>Chest measurement in cm:</b>	109	(117)	120	(125)	130	(136)
<b>Length in cm:</b>	70	(72)	74	(78)	80	(82)
<b>Color 06, balls:</b>	6	(8)	8	(8)	8	(9)
<b>Needles:</b>	US 15/UK 000					
<b>Circular needles:</b>	US 15/UK 000					
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower Easy Knit. 53 % Wool, 47% Acrylic, 80 m pr. 100 gram.					
<b>Gauge:</b>	7½ sts and 14 r in stockinette on needles US 15/UK 000 = 10 x 10 cm					

**To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.**

**Stockinette:** Knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side / Knit on all rounds.

**Reverse stockinette:** Purl on the right side, knit on the wrong side / Purl on all rounds.

### Back and front pieces are knitted together until the sleeves.

Cast on 82(86)90(94)98(102) sts on circular needles US 15/UK 000 and knit around in reverse stockinette. When you have knitted 8 cm = 12 rnds, continue in stockinette. Continue straight up, until the work measures 49(50)51(52)53(54) cm. Now divide the work at the beginning of the rnd and after 41(43)45(47)49(51) sts for back and front piece.

#### Back.

Knit straight up in stockinette over the 41(43)45(47)49(51) sts, until the armhole measures 9(10)11(12)13(14) cm. From here the rest is knitted in reverse stockinette. When the armhole measures 19(20)21(22)23(24) cm, put the middle 11 (11)13(13)15(15) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 2 sts. When the armhole measures 21(22)23(24)25(26) cm, put the remaining 13(14)14(15)15(16) sts on a stitch holder for the shoulder. Knit the other side mirrored.

#### Front.

Knit like the back, but with a deeper neckline: when the armhole measures 16(17)18(19) 20(21) cm, put the middle 7(7)9(9)11(11) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 2 sts and 2 x 1 sts. When the armhole has the same height as on the back, knit the 13 (14)14(15)15(16) shoulder stitches together with the corresponding sts on the back: put the needles together knit wise and knit the sts together with one sts from each needle. Fasten off the sts at the same time. Knit the other side mirrored.

#### Sleeves.

Cast on 22(22)24(24)26(26) sts and knit 8 cm = 12 rows in reverse stockinette, while on the 10th row increase 1 sts in both sides. Then continue in stockinette and repeat the increases on every 10th row a total of 6 times = 34(34)36(36)38(38) sts. When the sleeve measures 50(50)51(51)52(52) cm, fasten off loosely. Knit another sleeve matching.

#### Seaming.

Neckband: With the circular needles knit up along the neckline of the front piece 7 sts + the waiting 7(7)9(9)11(11) sts + 7 sts and along the neckline of the back 3 sts + the waiting 11(11)13(13)15(15) sts + 3 sts = in total 38(38)42 (42)46(46)) sts. Knit 3 rnds all purl sts and fasten off purl wise on the 4th rnd. Sew the sleeves together and sew them on.
