1776 – Short cardigan in basketweave pattern in Mayflower Super Kid Silk.

Size:	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)	XXXXL
Chest measurement in cm:	94	(104)	114	(124)	134	(144)	154
Length in cm:	55	(56)	57	(58)	59	(60)	61
Color 29, Pastel blue, balls:	5	(5)	6	(6)	6	(7)	8
Needles:	US 8/UK 6						
Circular needles 40 cm:	US 7/UK 7						
Cable needle:	US 8/UK 6						
Quality:	Mayflower Super Kid Silk. 76 % Kid Mohair, 24 % Silk, 195 m pr. 25 grams.						
Gauge:	Horizontal: 22 sts = 10 cm. Vertical: 27 rows = 10 cm. In stockinette.						

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

It is a good idea to read through the pattern, before starting the work, also it is a good idea to make a swatch and wet block it.

The basketweave pattern is knitted in stockinette with 2 knit wise knitted edge sts on all parts.

Procedure.**Back.**

- 1: Cast on 114(126)138(150)162(174)186 sts on needles US 8/UK 6 and knit 2 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2: Then knit all sts on a row (right side) while increasing to 124(136)148(160)172(184)196 sts evenly spread. Knit a row with all purl sts.
- 3: Continue in pattern following the diagram.
- 4: Knit until the entire work measures 54(55)56(57)58(59)60 cm from the bottom edge.
- 5: Fasten off the middle 44(46)48(50)52(54)56 sts for the neck and finish each side apart.
- 6: Fasten off 1x2 sts towards the neck side and fasten off the remaining sts all at once. Applies to all sizes.
- 7: Knit the other side mirrored.

Front.

- 1: Cast on 62(70)76(82)88(94)100 sts on needles US 8/UK 6 and knit ribbing like on the back.
- 2: The knit a row if knit sts (right side) and increase to 68(76)84(90)96(106)112 sts evenly spread. Knit a row of purl sts.
- 3: Continue in pattern following the diagram until the entire work measures 44(45)46(47)48(49)50 cm from the bottom edge.
- 4: Then fasten off for the neck in the individual sizes:
S: 1x11, 2x6, 1x3, 1x2 sts.
M: 1x11, 2x6, 1x3 and 3x2 sts.
L: 1x11, 2x6, 2x3, 2x2 sts.
XL: 1x10, 2x6, 2x3, 3x2 sts.
XXL: 1x12, 2x6, 1x3, 4x2 sts.
XXXL: 1x14, 2x6, 2x3, 2x2
XXXL: 1x16, 2x6, 4x3, 2x2 sts.
- 5: Knit straight up until the front piece has the same length as the back.
- 6: Knit the other front piece mirrored.


Sleeves.

- 1: Cast on 42(44)46(48)50(52)54 sts on needles US 8/UK 6 and knit 2 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2: Then knit a row of knit sts (right side) while increasing to 52(55)58(61)64(67)70 sts evenly spread. Knit a row of purl sts.
- 3: Continue in pattern while increasing 1 sts in each side on every 4th row until you have 94(97)100(106)111(115)120 sts. The pattern is knitted as you increase.
- 4: Knit straight up until the entire sleeve from the bottom edge measures 48(50)52(54)56(58)60 cm or the desired length. Fasten off loosely.
- 5: Knit another sleeve.

Assembly.


- 1: Sew the shoulder hems.
- 2: Sew the sleeves on so they don't tighten or bulk.
- 3: sew the side and sleeve hems.
- 4: On circular needles US 7/UK 7 knit approx. 120 sts up around the neck. Make sure you have the same amount of sts in the right and left neck side. Knit 2 cm and fasten off in ribbing.
- 5: Wet block the cardigan.
